Statutory fee Church of England Wedding service (2026) £566

Fees for reading of banns £39

If either of you do not live in the Walbury Beacon Benefice, banns will also need to be read in your home church.

Fee payable to your home church for banns to be read £39

Certificate of banns £20

Optional facilities & fees

The support of a Verger £50

Church heating (Oct – May) or if required at other time of year £30

Organist £130 Bells £75

We ask for a pre-payment of £100 to book your wedding.

Optional Facilities for Weddings and further information

We are pleased to offer, should you require them, the following services:

The Support of a Verger who will meet you before the day and discuss with you such matters as your preferred seating arrangements and any special needs that you or others who are coming may have, and to agree the help that be given on the day.

Having a Verger is recommended for all Weddings.

Church Heating can be provided. It must be booked in advance with a minimum of 24 hours' notice.

Parking is on-street, in the road outside the church and nearby. If disabled parking is required please mention this to the Churchwardens.

Bells. West Woodhay has 2 bells; these can be rung at your request.

Flowers. Please note that the church's policy of providing flowers for the following Sunday Services should be complied with except during Lent and Advent when flowers should be removed after the Wedding Service.

Photography and Video. Please ask your photographer/videographer to check with the member of clergy before the service as to where it is appropriate to stand etc. Photographs are welcome during the service and at the signing of the Register after they have been signed and can we ask that flash photography is not used.

Confetti – Biodegradable only please, at the church gates.

Organist and Music. An organ and organist are available, however organising this is your responsibility. Please contact Chris Lambert for further information.
